

## **Perspective announces the winners of A&D TROPHY AWARDS 2019 in Hong Kong**

[2 December, 2019] After months of short-listings and careful deliberation by a stellar panel of industry leaders, Perspective has announced the winners of the A&D TROPHY AWARDS 2019.

A record number of entries were received to cap another year of impressive achievements made by the architectural and design communities across Asia. For the 16th year in a row, the awards continue to applaud the best of recent architecture, interiors and product designs.

The gala presentation evening for the A&D TROPHY AWARDS 2019 and A&D CHINA AWARDS 2019 was held at ArtisTree, Quarry Bay, on December 2. In attendance were more than 250 guests, including shortlisted award winners, judges, architects and interior designers, as well as luminaries of the regional architect and design industries.

“Celebrating excellence in architecture and design is the essence of Perspective and the quality of work of the 2019 A&D Award winners was outstanding. A Best of Category award and an Excellence award are given to each respective sub-category in recognition of outstanding entries, while the Titanium awards have been introduced this year to replace the previously named Best of the Best awards. Among major winners were Ronald Lu & Partners, Shanghai PTArchitects, Cheng Chung Design (CCD), Matrix Design and LIXIL. The awards this year also welcomed a roster of up-and-coming practices such as Linehouse and OPENUU.

The winners of the Titanium awards--which goes to the highest-scoring entry of the Architecture, Interior Design and Product Design category respectively--were presented to the following projects:

- Neri&Hu Design and Research Office – Aranya Art Center (Architecture)
- Shanghai Hip-Pop Design Team – Jinyu Spa (Interior Design)
- Neri&Hu Design and Research Office – LAN collection for GAN (Product Design)
- Jennifer Yip, The University of Hong Kong – Hong Kong Tomorrow Vision (Student Architecture)

The highest honour of the night, The Best Architecture and Design Practice award, was awarded to Neri&Hu Design and Research Office, who swept up an impressive seven awards for their exceptional portfolio on projects that range from a public art centre to a pop-up exhibition and a furniture collection.

On the jury this year is a panel of leading architects and designers. On the Architecture panel were Dara Huang, Piero Lissoni, Heidar Sadeki, William Lim and Song Zhaoqing. On the Interior Design panel were Tara Bernerd, Alan Chan, Kinney Chan and Teo Su Seam. On the Product Design panel were Mario Trimarchi, Ben McCarthy, Johan Persson and Michael Young.

An impressive panel of established professionals of the local architectural and design community sat on the jury for the student category awards. On the Architecture panel: Jason Hilgefert, Marisa Yiu and Matthew Potter; on the Interior Design panel: Enoch Hui, Kelvin Kwong and Regina Kwok; and on the Product Design panel: Clifton Leung, Elaine Ng and William Wayne Lau.
